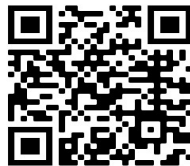

## The Easter Triduum

The Easter Triduum is the period in which Catholic and non-Catholic Christian liturgy commemorate the passion, death, and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. It constitutes the central moment of Holy Week and the liturgical year.

In the Roman Catholic liturgy, it extends from the evening of Holy Thursday, the end of Lent, until Easter Sunday. It has the following highlights:

- **Holy Thursday:** commemorates Jesus' Last Supper, the institution of the Eucharist and Holy Orders, and the commandment of love. It is a season of Lent until mid-evening, when Easter officially begins.
- **Good Friday:** A day of meditation on the passion of Jesus, with the celebration of the Lord's Passion. Along with Holy Saturday, the Eucharist is not celebrated.
- **Holy Saturday:** A day without liturgical celebrations in memory of the Burial of the Lord and the Solitude of Mary.
- **Easter Sunday:** begins with the celebration of the Easter Vigil on Saturday night or Sunday morning, which solemnly commemorates the resurrection of Jesus and is the most important Catholic liturgical event. After Vespers, the Easter Triduum concludes. The Octave of Easter begins on this Sunday.

Saint Ambrose called it the *Triduum Sacrum*, and Saint Augustine called it the *Sacratissimum Triduum*. The term "Easter Triduum" came into use around

## El Triduo Pascual

El Triduo Pascual es el tiempo en que la liturgia cristiana católica y no católica conmemoran la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo y constituye el momento central de la Semana Santa y del año litúrgico.

En la liturgia católica romana, comprende desde la tarde del Jueves Santo, cuando concluye la Cuaresma, hasta el Domingo de Pascua. Tiene los siguientes momentos destacados:

- **Jueves Santo:** se recuerdan la Última Cena de Jesús, la institución de la Eucaristía y del Orden Sacerdotal, y el mandamiento del amor, es Tiempo de Cuaresma hasta la media tarde, oficialmente inicia el Tiempo de Pascua.
- **Viernes Santo:** día de meditación sobre la pasión de Jesús, con la Celebración de la Pasión del Señor, junto con el Sábado de Gloria no se celebra la Eucaristía.
- **Sábado Santo:** Día sin celebraciones litúrgicas en recuerdo de la Sepultura del Señor y la Soledad de María.
- **Domingo de Pascua:** comienza con la celebración de la Vigilia Pascual en la noche del sábado o madrugada del domingo, en la que se conmemora con solemnidad la resurrección de Jesús, y que es el acto litúrgico católico más destacado. Tras el rezo de Vísperas finaliza el Triduo Pascual. Desde este domingo inicia la Octava de Pascua.

San Ambrosio le llamo *Triduum Sacrum* y San Agustín *Sacratissimum Triduum*. La expresión "Triduo Pascual" se empezó a usar alrededor de los años 1930.
