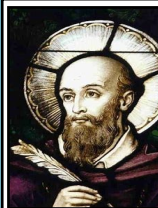

“Stay with us, Lord”

This is the urgent plea of faith that the two disciples made to the fellow traveler they encountered on the road to Emmaus—a supplication of faith that recognizes the living presence of Jesus amidst the twilight of life or in times of difficulty. For this reason, we, too, offer this very same prayer to the Lord. Jesus invites us to communion, with the Eucharist serving as the primary means by which He remains with us.

This phrase is uttered when “evening falls,” symbolizing moments of doubt, discouragement, or pain—times when the light of Christ is most needed. Jesus remains with us not in a merely physical sense, but in a real and sacramental manner through the breaking of the bread, renewing His sacrifice through the power of the Holy Spirit. God respects our freedom and waits to be invited—just as the disciples did at Emmaus—so that He may enter and transform our hearts.

“Stay with us, Lord” is the prayer of a heart that seeks Jesus; the prayer of a heart that yearns for the presence of Jesus. It is the prayer of a heart that ardently desires the companionship of Jesus—His friendship—throughout our journey. It is the prayer of a heart that longs to be united with Jesus.

“Stay, Lord; never leave us”—this is the very definition of holiness: a desire to be united with Jesus; a union with Christ Our Lord. Yet, if we invite Jesus to stay, He takes us at our word; He enters into our lives and remains with us. Jesus does not wish to be merely a casual guest, but rather an eternal companion. He does not come to pay a neighborly call or to make a sales pitch; rather, He is a friend, He is family—He is the Lord, and He desires that you make Him the Lord of your life.

It is a prayer of trust that seeks refuge in the love of God, assuring us of protection and guidance in our daily walk. To this very day, He continues to say to us: “Behold, I stand at your door and knock; I will enter your home and dine with you.”



“Quédate con nosotros, Señor”

Esta es la urgente petición de fe que los dos discípulos hicieron al nuevo caminante que encontraron en el camino a Emaús, es una súplica de fe que reconoce la presencia viva de Jesús tras el atardecer de la vida o las dificultades. Por eso nosotros también hacemos esa misma oración al Señor. Jesús nos invita a la comunión, siendo la Eucaristía el modo principal en que Él permanece con nosotros.

Esta frase se pronuncia cuando “atardece”, simbolizando momentos de duda, desánimo o dolor, donde se necesita la luz de Cristo. Jesús se queda con nosotros no de forma física, sino real y sacramental en la fracción del pan, renovando su sacrificio por el poder del Espíritu Santo. Dios respeta nuestra libertad y espera a ser invitado, como hicieron los discípulos en Emaús, para entrar y transformar nuestros corazones.

“Quédate con nosotros, Señor”, es la oración de un corazón que está buscando a Jesús; la oración de un corazón que desea la presencia de Jesús. Es la oración de un corazón que desea ardientemente la compañía de Jesús, su amistad en nuestra jornada. Es la oración de un corazón que desea estar unido a Jesús.

Quédate, Señor, no te vayas nunca, es la definición de santidad: un deseo de estar unidos con Jesús: unión con Cristo Nuestro Señor. Pero si invitamos a Jesús a quedarse, Él nos toma la palabra, entra en nuestra vida y se queda con nosotros. Jesús no quiere ser un invitado cualquiera, sino un eterno compañero. No quiere hacerte visita de vecino o de vendedor, más bien es amigo, familia, es el Señor y quiere que lo hagas Señor de tu vida.

Es una oración de confianza que busca refugio en el amor de Dios, asegurando protección y guía en el caminar diario. Él sigue diciéndonos hoy *“mira que estoy a tu puerta y te llamo, entraré en su casa y comeré contigo”*.
