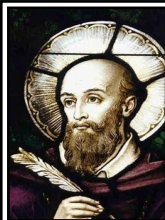

**“Whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do even greater works.”**

This promise of Jesus, found in the Gospel of John, does not imply surpassing His divine power; rather, thanks to His Ascension and the sending of the Holy Spirit, the Church would expand its evangelizing work on a global scale. The “greater works” refer to spiritual impact: the conversion and salvation of countless souls through the Gospel.

The condition is to believe in the One whom God sent and to live in intimate communion with the Father, allowing Christ to act through us in our daily lives. The “greater works” are primarily spiritual: the resurrection of the spiritually dead (sinners) to the life of grace—surpassing, in both geographic scope and sheer numbers, the physical miracles Jesus performed in Palestine.

Jesus did not depart to leave us alone, but rather so that, through the Holy Spirit, we might become His hands and feet in the world. He desires that we live out the Gospel, preach the Word, love our neighbors, and work for justice, bringing the life of Christ to every corner of the earth.

Jesus assures us that whatever we ask of the Father in His name, for the glory of God, will be granted—thereby empowering the faithful to carry on His mission. This does not imply that the disciples are superior to Jesus, but rather that the ministry of the Church—driven by the Holy Spirit—would carry the message of salvation to the entire world, reaching a scope far greater than that of His own earthly ministry.

In summary, Jesus invites us to be active witnesses of Christ’s love and salvation, trusting that He acts through our faith and works of love—thereby glorifying the Father and bringing about miracles of conversion and charity.



**“El que crea en mí, hará las obras que hago yo y las hará aún mayores”**

Esta promesa de Jesús que encontramos en el Evangelio de Juan no implica superar su poder divino, sino que, gracias a su Ascensión y al envío del Espíritu Santo, la Iglesia expandiría su obra evangelizadora a nivel mundial. Las "obras mayores" se refieren al impacto espiritual: la conversión y salvación de incontables almas a través del Evangelio.

La condición es creer en aquel que Dios envió y vivir en comunión íntima con el Padre, permitiendo que Cristo actúe a través de nosotros en la vida cotidiana. Las "obras mayores" son principalmente espirituales: la resurrección de muertos espirituales (pecadores) a la vida de gracia, superando en extensión geográfica y numérica los milagros físicos de

Jesús en Palestina.

Jesús no se fue para dejarnos solos, sino para que, mediante el Espíritu Santo, seamos sus manos y pies en el mundo. Él quiere que vivamos el Evangelio, que prediquemos la palabra, amemos al prójimo y trabajemos por la justicia, llevando la vida de Cristo a todos los rincones.

Jesús nos garantiza que todo lo que pidamos al Padre en su nombre para la gloria de Dios será hecho, capacitando a los fieles para continuar su misión. Y esto no significa que los discípulos sean superiores a Jesús, sino que el ministerio de la Iglesia, impulsado por el Espíritu Santo, llevaría el mensaje de salvación a todo el mundo, un alcance mayor al de su ministerio terrenal.

En resumen, Jesús nos invita a ser testigos activos del amor y la salvación de Cristo, confiando en que El actúa a través de nuestra fe y obras de amor, glorificando al Padre, realizando milagros de conversión y caridad.
