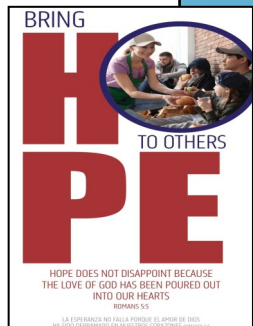

**“My sheep hear my voice”
(John 10:27)**

In the Gospel of Saint John, we find the phrase "My sheep hear my voice," and this is a powerful teaching from Jesus about the relationship between him and his followers. This relationship is based on trust, mutual knowledge, and the security that Jesus offers his sheep.

Jesus' sheep not only hear his voice, but also recognize and respond to it. This is a gift of the Holy Spirit, which allows believers to understand that Jesus is their guide amid the diverse voices of the world. Jesus assures his sheep that no one will snatch them from his hand.

By referring to his followers as "my sheep," Jesus affirms that they are known, loved, and valued by him. This identity is not earned by human effort, but is bestowed by grace through faith.

The sheep trust their shepherd, knowing that he guides them, protects them, and gives them life. Obedient listening is key to faith and eternal life. Trust in His love and care, and do not doubt His promise of eternal salvation.

The Lord will bless you if you obey His voice, even if you sometimes don't understand His purpose. Take time to listen to His voice, communicate with Him, and He will share your worries and joys. Accept His invitation to be part of God's flock.

**“Mis ovejas escuchan mi voz”
(Juan 10:27)**

En el Evangelio del Apóstol San Juan encontramos la frase "Mis ovejas escuchan mi voz" y esta es una poderosa enseñanza de Jesús sobre la relación entre él y sus seguidores. Esta relación se basa en la confianza, el conocimiento mutuo, y la seguridad que Jesús ofrece a sus ovejas.

Las ovejas de Jesús no solo oyen su voz, sino que la reconocen y responden a ella. Este es un regalo del Espíritu Santo, que permite a los creyentes entender que Jesús es su guía en medio de las diversas voces del mundo. Jesús asegura a sus ovejas que nadie las arrebatará de su mano.

Al referirse a sus seguidores como "mis ovejas", Jesús afirma que son conocidos, amados y valorados por él. Esta identidad no se gana por esfuerzo humano, sino que se otorga por gracia a través de la fe.

Las ovejas confían en su pastor, sabiendo que él las guía, las protege y les da la vida. La escucha obediente es clave para la fe y la vida eterna. Ten confianza en su amor y cuidado, y no dudes de su promesa de salvación eterna.

El Señor te bendecirá si obedeces su voz, aunque a veces no entiendas su propósito, toma tiempo para escuchar su voz, comunícate con él y El compartirá tus preocupaciones y alegrías, acepta su invitación de ser parte del rebaño de Dios.
