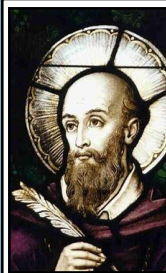

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Each year, on the first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, also known as Trinity Sunday. It was Pope John XXII who officially established this feast on the Church's liturgical calendar.

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity honors the fundamental dogma and central mystery of the Christian faith: that God is a single divine being in three distinct and equal persons—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In the Catholic Church, this feast synthesizes the creative, redemptive, and sanctifying work of the Trinity, enabling the faithful to offer praise to the unity and majesty of God.

The Lauds hymn appointed for this Sunday reads: “The one and triune God, mystery of love, dwells in the heavens and within my heart,” reminding us that we are invited to share in the intimate life of God—the source of inexhaustible love.

By revealing His Trinitarian nature to us, God draws us into the greatest mystery: that while He is perfect unity, He is also a community of Persons. And, although the divine immensity may remain unfathomable to us, our hearts overflow with gratitude for the gift we have received—an infinite and immeasurable gift of Love!

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, in paragraph 234, tells us that the Trinity “is the mystery of God in Himself.” God has revealed Himself to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Let us, therefore, humbly open our hearts to God—one and triune—so that each Person of the Trinity may take His rightful place in our lives.

Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad

Cada año, en el primer domingo después de Pentecostés, celebramos la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, también conocida como el Domingo de la Trinidad. Fue el Papa Juan XXII que estableció oficialmente la fiesta en el calendario litúrgico de la Iglesia.

La Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad honra el dogma fundamental y misterio central de la fe cristiana: que Dios es un único ser divino en tres personas distintas e iguales: el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. En la Iglesia católica, esta fiesta sintetiza la obra creadora, redentora y santificadora de la Trinidad, permitiendo a los fieles alabar la unidad y majestad de Dios.

El himno de las laudes correspondiente a este domingo dice así: “El Dios uno y trino, misterio de amor, habita en los cielos y en mi corazón”, recordándonos que estamos invitados a tomar parte de la vida íntima de Dios, fuente de amor inacabable.

Al revelarnos su naturaleza trinitaria, Dios nos introduce en el misterio más grande: siendo Él unidad perfecta, es también comunidad de Personas. Y, aunque la inmensidad divina nos resulte insondable, nuestro corazón rebosa agradecido por el don recibido, ¡don infinito e inmensurable de Amor!

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica en el Núm. 234 nos dice que la Trinidad: “Es el misterio de Dios en sí mismo”. Dios se nos ha revelado a sí mismo como Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Abramos, pues, con humildad, el corazón a Dios, uno y trino; que cada Persona de la Trinidad ocupe un lugar en nuestras vidas.
